When this Belgian bank relocated its U.S. Headquarters, they selected BGA to design their new offices in the landmark, Art Deco Rockefeller Center Office building complex. The program requirements included three major divisions: Banking, Trading Room and an Operations Center. Project features include:



- A floorplan layout which capitalized on the “H” shape of the 38,000 S.F. space to organize the facility by naturally separating the Banking and Operations Departments from the centrally located Reception, Boardroom, Executive and Administration Departments
- Integrating a raised floor system to accommodate wiring and allow for maximum flexibility throughout 75% of the space including the Foreign Exchange Trading Room
- Minimizing the use of private offices and maximizing the use of systems furniture to allow for greater flexibility of staff growth or change in any one department
- A custom ceiling and lighting design for the Boardroom and the Reception Area, plus oversize doors to tie these two spaces together, creating one large open space for social functions
- Coordination of window louvers with the NYC Landmarks Preservation Commission
