

## *International Securities Exchange (ISE) – 60 Broad Street, New York, NY*

In 1999, this newly established, on-line Securities Exchange required a solid presence and established infrastructure systems before they opened for business. Primarily, they needed to develop a robust Data Center with capacity for growth, redundant backup systems and the feasibility of integrating a generator. Key elements of BGA's design for the (2) full-floor build out in New York City's Financial District included:



- Coordination with the Data Center firm, Mechanical Engineers and the firm's IT Department to prioritize requirements for the large Data Center, in terms of capacity, equipment and infrastructure systems
- Investigation of the Fire Suppression systems with the Engineers, prior to the selection of the FM-200 system, and its subsequent integration
- Design of a visually striking Reception Area and Boardroom, incorporating clear and frosted glass, wood-trimmed pendant lights that appear to 'pierce' the glass wall
- Design of a custom stair linking the (2) floors of the organization
